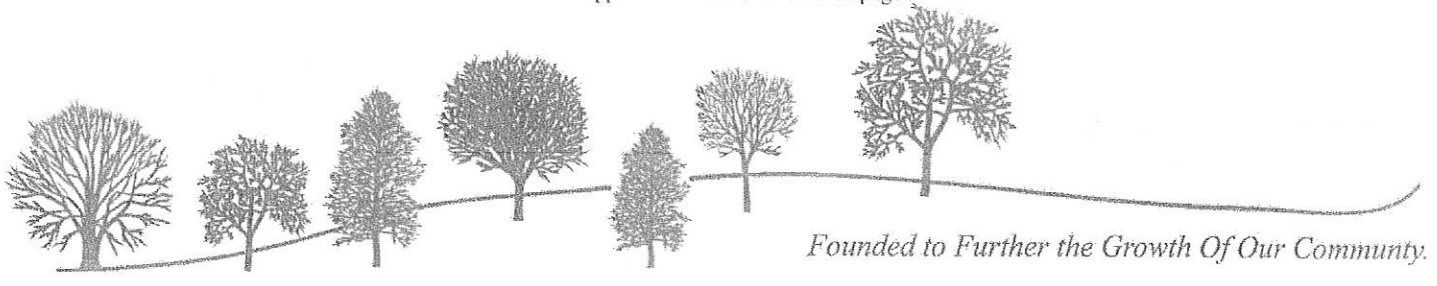

B. Your organization's history, activities, services, and composition. (Videos are of limited use.)

Family Advocates, Inc. was incorporated in 1982 providing services to victims and survivors of domestic violence, sexual assault, child abuse, and elder abuse. Currently, the agency has offices and an emergency shelter in Grant County as well as offices in Iowa and Lafayette counties. All services offered are free and confidential. The agency offers emergency shelter, peer counseling, group counseling, legal advocacy, medical advocacy, criminal justice advocacy, parenting, and childrens groups as well as childrens peer counseling. Family Advocates, Inc. also provides awareness, prevention, and education presentations to schools, agencies, organizations, and communities. The agency is governed by a Board of Directors. The Executive Director oversees day-to-day operations of the agency. The agency is staffed 24 hours a day. Currently there are 15 staff members in addition to the Director as well as numerous volunteers.

Applications are considered in June and December of each year. The corresponding deadlines are May 1<sup>st</sup> and November 1<sup>st</sup>. Concise grants that address the needed information are appreciated.

## Supporting Information

1. Grant dollars will be used to replace three toilets in the shelter facility for Family Advocates, Inc. as well as one washing machine and two dryers.
2. Immediately upon receipt of the grant award, Weygant's Appliance and Mattress will be contacted to replace the washer and dryers at the facility. The proposed dollar amount includes the removal of the old units from the shelter. Top Notch Plumbing, Heating, and Electrical will also be contacted to remove the toilets and replace with newer, more efficient products. The replacement of the items will occur as quickly as schedules can accommodate.
3. There will be no other sources of funding for this project.
4. Currently, the toilets that are installed at Family Advocates, Inc. shelter facility are quite old and use higher volumes of water in order to function. In addition, the toilets do not function well creating the need for plumbing services. The current washing machine and dryers are also quite old and use higher volumes of water as well as energy. Toilets, dryers, and the washing machine have needed a number of repairs and services over the course of the past few years. In postponing the replacement of these items, additional costs will be incurred as well as the overuse of natural resources.
5. Clients residing in the shelter facility will benefit from the replacement of the toilets, dryers, and washing machine. With the current items, at least one toilet has been unable to be used during various times due to malfunctions and needed repairs. The same holds true for the dryers. Additionally, the washing machine is often in need of repairs, which creates the inability to wash clothing and bedding. Shelter residents receive all services free of charge at Family Advocates, Inc. as do all clientele. With the impending repairs that are needed on the toilets, washer, and dryers, dollars are spent which could be utilized in other areas including programming and providing services to clients.
