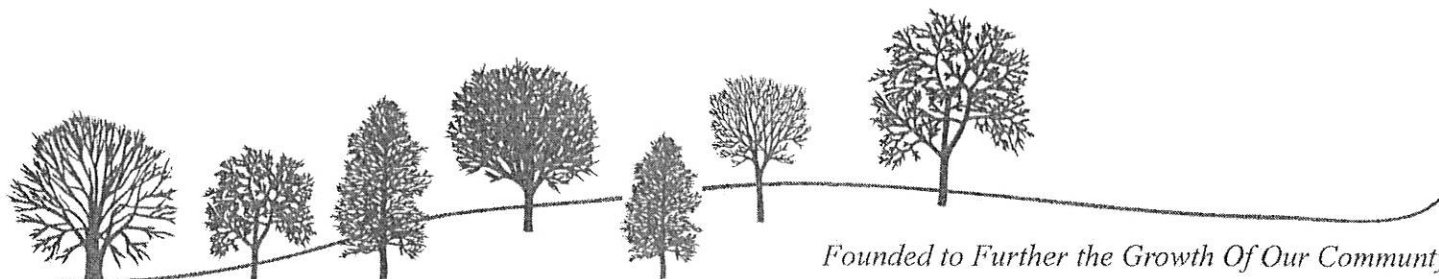

A. Supporting Information

1. Specific use of the grant funds

Upland Hills Health is requesting funds toward the purchase of a new Stryker birthing bed. The current birthing bed we are seeking to replace is 14 years old and needs frequent maintenance. Hill-Rom, the manufacturer, no longer makes parts for this bed and will not service this model.

The new Stryker birthing bed has many ergonomic features. The foot of the bed is very easy to remove for deliveries and to replace following deliveries. We have a contract to maintain Stryker beds.

2. Time Schedule

We would like to purchase the bed at the end of 2013 or at the beginning of 2014.

3. Other sources of funding

The Elmer G Biddick Charitable Foundation is the only organization Upland Hills Health is approaching for assistance. The hospital will use its own funds designated for capital purchases to supplement the donated funds to complete the purchase. Should we receive the requested funding, we would acknowledge the donation through our press release concerning the purchase of the bed.

4. Describe the effect of postponing your request to another time.

Upland Hills Health cannot delay the purchase of the bed for another year as the bed we seek to replace was recently removed from use because it gets stuck in various positions, making it difficult for staff to change the position of the bed during deliveries.

If we do not receive the requested funds from the Elmer G. Biddick Charitable Foundation, we will need to seek funds elsewhere.

5. Describe who, when, how and where the effects of this grant will be felt.

The birthing bed will be utilized for mothers who choose to give birth at Upland Hills Health. Last year, the hospital delivered 286 babies. The new birthing bed will add to the comfort of the birthing experience for our mothers -to-be.

B. Your organization's history, activities, services, and composition.

Upland Hills Health is a non-profit organization guided by a Board of Directors consisting of dedicated community leaders that generously volunteer their time and

talents. Upland Hills Health currently employs over 400 individuals and has over 75 active volunteers. Upland Hills Health was formed as the result of a merger of two Dodgeville hospitals: St. Joseph's Hospital and Dodgeville General Hospital. They came together in 1974 as a united non-profit organization, as Memorial Hospital of Iowa County, Inc. In 2001 the corporate identity was changed to Upland Hills Health to reflect a growing service area and expanded health services.
