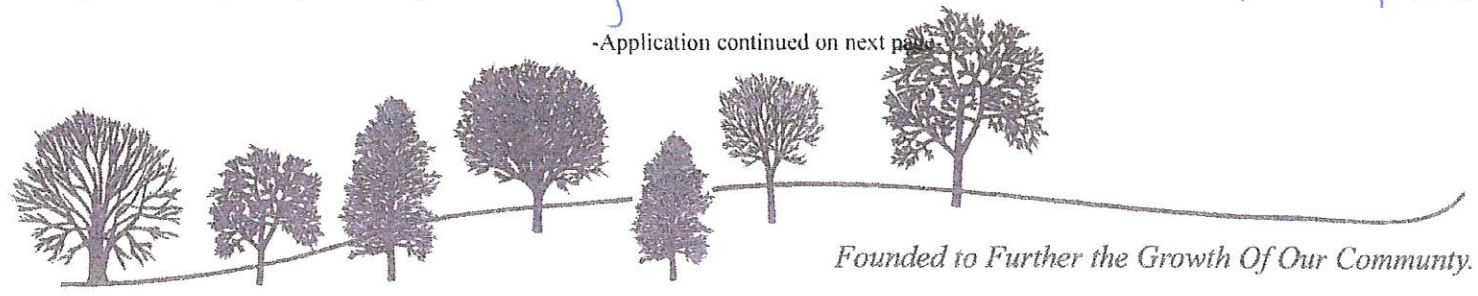

A. Supporting Information

1. Specific use of grant.

- i. The Elmer G. Biddick Charitable Foundation Grant would be used to offset the costs of bringing The Missoula Children's Theatre to IGEMS.

- 1. Our goal is to receive donations that total \$3,500.00 so that our families only have to pay \$25.00 or less for their child to participate in the summer theatre experience.

2. Time schedule

- i. Initially, we needed \$500 to secure a date for the summer of 2016. The IGEMS Parent Teacher Club donated the first \$500 to make that possible.
- ii. The next step is to raise the money needed so that we know how much to charge each participant. We would like those funds by December so we know if we will need to apply for other grants.
- iii. Finally, once we raise enough money to pay for our expenses, we will be able keep the profits from ticket sales (\$5 per person) to establish a fund for the following summer.

4. Describe the effect of postponing your request to another time.
 - i. If we are unable to cover the expenditures associated with the Missoula contract, the costs will need to be made up by the participants' families.

 - i. The effects of this grant will be far reaching.
 1. The most important effect will be upon the children who participate in the production. It will afford our rural students the opportunity to perform on stage. Thus, promoting their confidence and help them to gain a sense of pride in their abilities. They will be learning life skills such as talking in front of a group, team work, and pride in a job well done.
 2. Their parents and families will be affected. They will be able to see their child participate in a local, low cost venue under the direction of 2 professional directors.
 3. The community will be affected. By bringing The Missoula Children's Theatre to IGEMS, we will be promoting fine arts to our entire community. By applying for grants, we hope to use the money generated through ticket sales to sustain our summer theatre project from year to year. We hope to make Missoula an annual summer tradition at IGEMS!
- B. We are hoping to revitalize the IGEMS Theatre/ Drama Group. IGEMS has not had a theatre production for many years. As budgets are cut, we are actively seeking a way to inspire the children of our IG community while bringing a first rate performance to our area that every Panther can be proud of!
