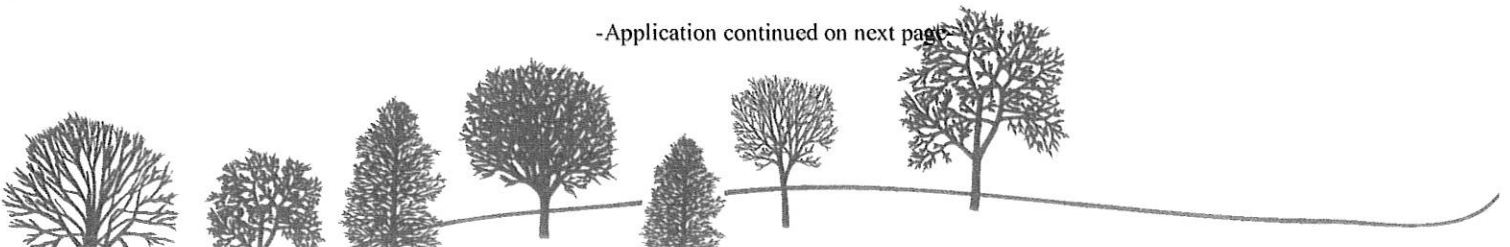

SUPPORTING INFORMATION

- 1) Showers & piping replaced (See attached quote from H&N Plumbing & Heating Inc.)
- 2) 3 weeks in May are needed to complete project so pool can be opened June 5th.
- 3) We have raised \$3,600 through online website GiveForward.com, bucket fundraiser, bake sale, and community donations.
- 4) For our pool to meet the standards for certification these repairs need to be completed, or we will not be able to open.
- 5) The Montfort Public Pool is scheduled to open from June 5th to August 16th to anyone in Iowa/Grant County. Our school district offers a shuttle service during this time to Livingston, Rewey, Linden, Edmund, & Cobb. During the summer, lifeguards offer swimming lessons to youth who want to better themselves. The impact of this grant goes beyond the needs of one small village, its effect will be felt by many.

B. Village of Montfort, “It takes a Village”, formed after a tragedy in town this year. Our group meets the third Saturday of every month and is composed of many different members of our community. Current activities, other than saving the pool, are creating and distributing welcoming information, advertising local businesses and committees, being a sounding board to citizens who have issues or ideas, and aiding in the communication between other organizations and the Montfort Trustees Board.
