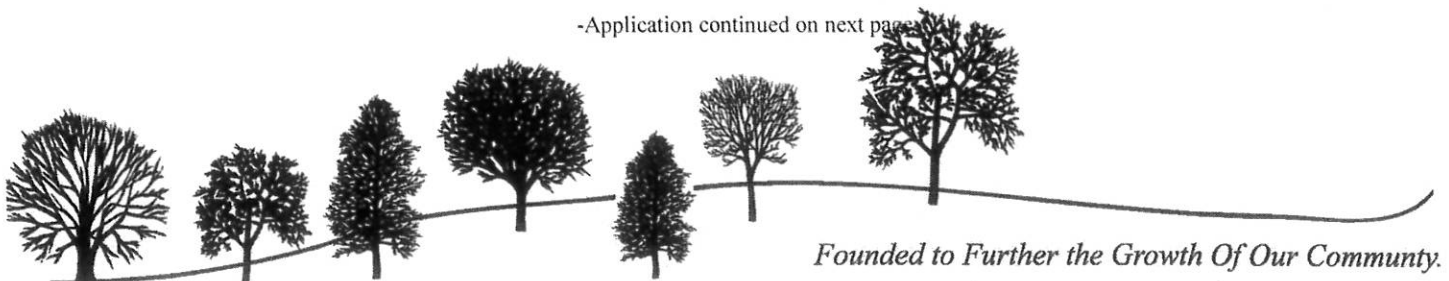

As we plan on ways to thank all those that have supported our squad we are also looking for ways to help community members at the same time. During the next year we plan to offer the "File of Life" information packet to all area residences. The File of Life is a form that households can complete and then placed in the magnetic vinyl folder and placed on the refrigerator. In case of an emergency to that residence and the person is unable to communicate to us we would look for this File of Life on the refrigerator for this document that would give us all of the pertinent information we would need to assist that person immediately allowing us expedite the care we offer.

Our goal is to offer the File of Life forms throughout our community this next summer at an open house event we are planning and during community events in our local communities. We have estimated this project at \$1,335.00 to cover the estimated 1400 households in our service area.

From time to time we receive donations from families that we have served and use this money to add new equipment to our squad, member training or for community awareness projects. Funds received this next year will be used to help us off-set the cost of this project but this is never a certain source of income.

The goal of this project is to place a "File of Life" in every household of the 67 square mile area that we serve. Our hope in doing so will just maybe help save someone's life in that critical time of need.

The Montfort Rescue Squad has been offering emergency medical care to the Iowa-Grant communities since 1958. We are comprised of 23 volunteer members which includes members licensed as Basic EMT's, Advanced EMT's and drivers. This group of volunteers provide emergency care 24/7 365 as well attending training throughout the year to maintain their licensure. 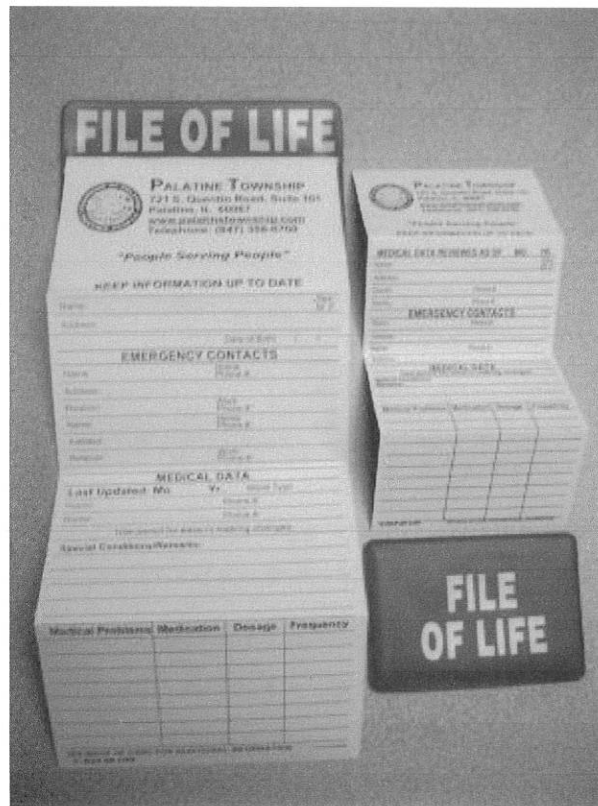
