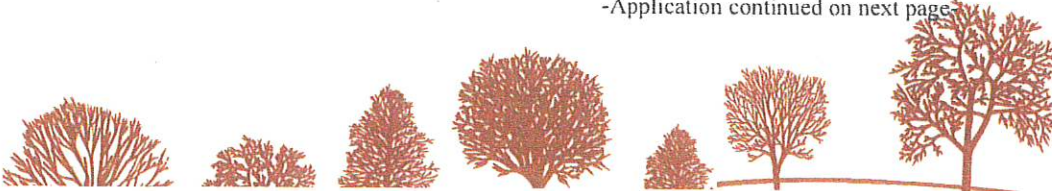

We have daily Mass here in church, except for Mondays. Our students use the church and so does our community. We host the annual Thanksgiving free meal in our kitchen/cafeteria at school. We also host speaking events for families in our church.

We are well known throughout our community, because we have been part of it for so long.

The parish supplements the school every year. We count on the support of our parish to keep our school running.

We are in need of an Automated External Defibrillator (AED) Machine here at our parish. We have Mass daily (except for Mondays) and several events that we host regularly in our church and gathering space in the back of church.

We have discussed this with our local EMS and Fire Station and would like to purchase a Zoll AED Machine. That is the type of machine they use and therefore ours would be compatible with theirs if we should have to use both machines simultaneously. They have also been trained on this specific machine so would be even more prepared if they did have to come here to assist.

Getting an AED Machine is a high priority for us. We want to be prepared in case anything should happen to one of our parishioners, students, or visitors while in the church.

If we were to get this grant, the entire amount would be used to purchase the AED Machine. If the grant money received did not fully cover the costs we would use money in our operating budget to purchase the machine.

If we were to postpone this request there is the potential that someone could have a cardiac event and we would not be prepared to help out or save a life.

We have approximately 400 parish families and 70 school families who all use the church at some time or another. We also host other events here at church, such as our annual Christmas Program that the school kids put on and Confirmation Class, just to name a few. We also have meetings and funeral visitations in our gathering space in the back of church so, in a year's time there are thousands of people from this community that enter our church for one reason or another.

This grant could potentially save more than one life in our community.
