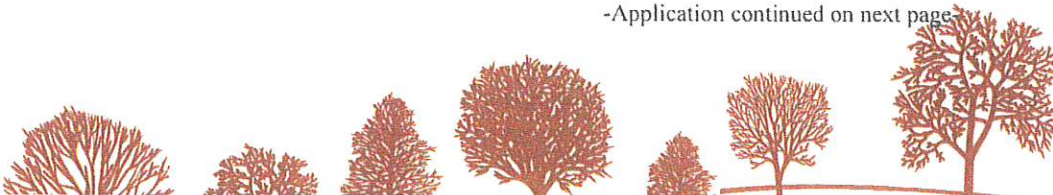

We would like to purchase a new laminator for our school. The one that was being used was an older unit and stopped working properly. Items were coming out wrinkled or ruined all together. Teachers were afraid to use it. The final straw was when it died and just plain would not work at all due to the unit getting jammed with every use.

Not having a laminator here at school has been more difficult than we anticipated. It is used by all of the teachers and the school secretary as well.

If we were to get this grant we would put all of the money towards the purchase of a new laminator. We want to get a 27" sized laminator because that was the size of our old one and we still have lamination sheet rolls that were not used yet on our old machine. That way we can reuse what we already have in stock. If the grant money did not fully cover the costs anticipated for the new machine, we would do an additional fundraiser to make up the difference. There is currently not money set aside in the budget to purchase a laminator on our own.

Postponing this request to another time would not be the end of the world, but it would pose a bit of a continued challenge to our teachers and staff.

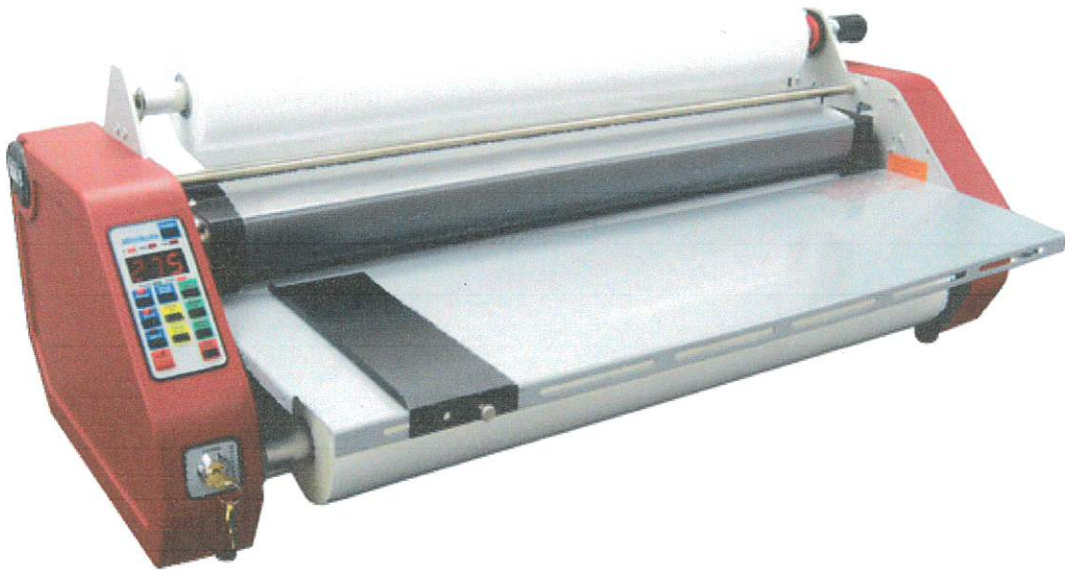
We are a PreK3 – 8th grade school with approximately 175 students and staff members. The effects of this grant will be felt throughout the entire school.
