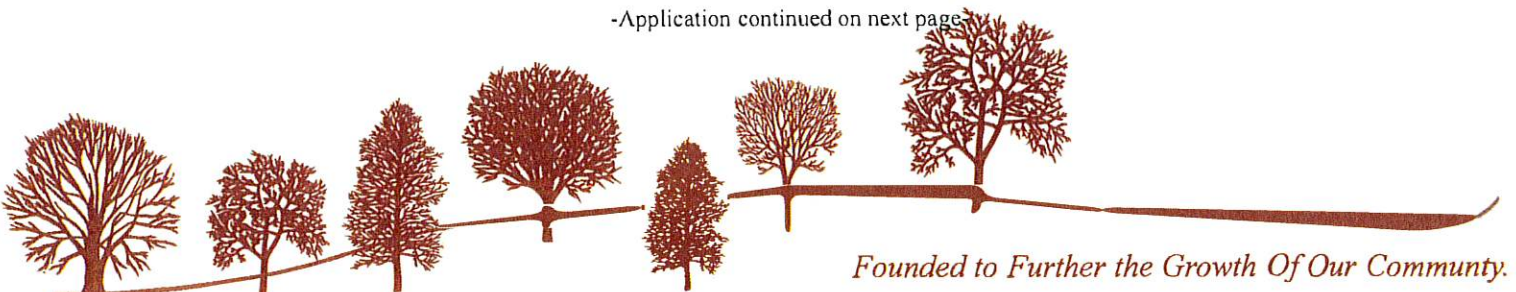

Highland School District has implemented the Senior Exit Project for the past 11 years as a graduation requirement. Senior Exit Project is a 45-minute class, that aims to instill the values of community service and assist students in exploring career paths or interests post-graduation. Securing the grant would enable me to carry on Harper Drury's project, ensuring that female students in the school have access to essential products. Upon my graduation, the health teacher will continue to stock the baskets with all the necessary items. There has been a significant amount of positive feedback making this project a huge success. We were able to buy 10 boxes of tampons and 7 boxes of pads. Thanks to the grant, we were able to provide support to 1,632 women in school who lacked access to feminine products. We are so grateful to the Biddick Foundation for allowing us to provide products to students in Highland Schools.
